EXHIBITORS BRIEFING NOTES

ACCESS INFORMATION:

GATES & ACCESS / TIMES: Gate 27 will be open from 6.00am for access into the exhibitor parking area. The showground will be locked overnight with no access until 6.00am. Please park responsibly taking due consideration to your neighbouring exhibitors

ENTRY PASSES: No tickets or wrist bands are provided for this event. Please **PRINT** a copy of your entry pack email showing your name and class listings and bring with you to the show. A list of names and vehicles (as provided with your entry) will be held at the gate in the case of any query. Note: Pass allocations are based on a maximum of 3 passes per equine entry.

VEHICLE PASSES: No vehicle passes are required for this event.

SHOWING INFORMATION:

HORSE PASSPORTS: A passport for every equine attending the show should accompany the animal and be available for inspection, if required. Random checks for vaccination records may be made via the show vets during the show (a minimum of 12 months cover is required for this event – please refer to Point 3, Additional General Information & Conditions, Show Schedule).

ACCESS TO SHOW RINGS:

Light & Heavy Horses – Use Gate 30 (Horse Walk) and Gate 24 (by Menage).

Private Driving & Scurry – Use Gate 33 for access to the Grand Ring

RIDING HAT RULES: Correctly secured Skull Caps or Riding Hats, conforming to the current BSI or European Standard or higher **MUST** be worn at all times by Judges, Competitors or anyone mounted on a horse or pony whilst on the Showground. **Such headgear must be worn with the chinstrap correctly and securely fastened at all times.**

EXHIBITOR BACK NUMBERS: These are NOT provided by the show. **Please use the link on the Equestrian Show web site as provided in your entry pack email to access the template.** Enter your class number into the template and print one copy per class and bring with you to the show. Please note – You will have different numbers for each class entered. Please ensure you use the correct number for the correct class on the day. We recommend a thicker-paper/card for durability. Eyelets positions are marked for strings to attach around the waist or use pins to attach to show jacket.

SHOW RINGS: The Show Rings are not available as practice rings under any circumstances.

RIDDEN SHOWS: A maximum of two minutes is allowed for each ridden show.

ROSETTES: 1st – 6th place rosettes will be awarded for all classes. Rosettes will not be handed to recipients, we kindly ask that you collect your own rosette from the basket held by the ring steward at the end of the class.

PRIZE MONEY & TRIOPHIES: No prize money or Trophies will be awarded.

GENERAL INFORMATION:

CATERING UNITS: These will be sited on the grass outside St Walstan Hall. Hoggies will be open for Breakfast. This will be supplement by additional catering options for lunch (Drifters Fish & Chips & Wrapbar). We are promoting contactless payment where possible.

RESULTS: Class Results will be posted on the glass windows of the Trophy Building outside the Showground Office. Results will also be online as soon as possible.

TRADE STAND: Tack & Turnout will be attending the show for all your equestrian needs, located in the centre of the showground between the Light Horse and Wensum Ring.
